##----- Monte' Williams' had 236 yds. and an 87-yd TD run; the Tigers added a 72-yard Dustin Allen to Michael Collins TD pass also; after falling behind (7-12), Commerce later led (21-18) in a tight game early in the third period, before the Tigers reel off (4) touchdowns in a row to rout Jefferson.

C-J Rivalry (33-15-5)

\$----- Most Commerce total offense in a game with 553 yards.

^----- The #1 ranked Tigers lose at Rabun County following a late Commerce TD but later missed the PAT.

^^----- Dustin Allen's 87-yard TD pass to Monte' Williams breaks the 45 year old record of 80 yards set in 1953.

^^^---- Commerce ended the regular season in a three way tie for region honors with GAC and Rabun Co. Because of the tie-breaker rules, the order of seeding in the region for the playoffs was RC-1, Com-2, GAC-3.

&----- Playoff game

OT---- Historically, this was the second overtime game played by Commerce. (1-1)

\$\$----- This is the first Tiger overtime victory, however, Monte' Williams broke his leg at the end of the first half, before the Tigers, behind QB Dustin Allen's 347 total yards (the most ever by any Tiger player; 100—rush, 247—pass), rallied Commerce to victory.

#----- Region game

\$----- Daniel Carder's 45-yard field goal is the longest in Tiger history; it was eventually tied by a Tommy Eason FG in 2001.

^----- Third most points scored by a Tiger team in a Jefferson game; Michael Collins returns the opening KO 83 yds. for a TD; Monte' Williams had 4 TD's in the rout (15, 11, 16 and 4). C-J Rivalry (34-15-5)

\$\$----- Monte' Williams had a school record (40) carries in the GAC game.

\$\$\$----- Daniel Carder's 297 yards passing is most ever for a Tiger player in a single game.

^^----- In this region championship game, neither team scored consecutive touchdowns. Commerce scored first and had six touchdowns, while Buford countered with five TD's. It was one of the most exciting Tiger games and offensive shows ever in Commerce football history. There was a total of 800 yards total offense in the game by both teams.
